	Social Security Number and contact information, FEIN, date of birth, driver's license information, driving record, VIN, income information, payroll, tax, or credit information, credit-based insurance scores, insurance claim history, payment history, motor vehicle reports, claim and loss history reports, business records, and property records.

What we do			
How does GUARD protect my personal information?		To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we implement security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.	
How does GUARD collect my personal information?		 We collect your personal information, for example, when you: apply for insurance; pay insurance premiums; file an insurance claim; submit information in furtherance of a claim; give us your income information; or give us your contact information. We also collect information from third parties such as consumer reporting agencies, our affiliates, or unaffiliated companies, including your insurance agent or producer, consumer reporting agencies, data providers, and insurance advisory and rating organizations. 	
Why can't I limit all sharing?		 Federal law gives you the right to limit only: sharing for affiliates everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for non-affiliates to market to you. 	
		State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing	
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?		Your choices will apply to everyone on your policy.

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • This includes affiliated companies that are also subsidiaries of Berkshire Hathaway Inc		
Non-affiliates	Companies not related to us by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.		
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.
